



Have fun with Marty

We can read about Marty and have fun colouring his adventures, but we can also act his story out to see what it feels like to fall onto planet earth. Acting out the story means extra special fun because it's when your greatest adventure begins: your journey on planet earth!

MATERIAL

- 1 garden agility tunnel
- Yellow, orange, red, blue, violet, green, indigo paint
- Big paint brushes
- A long piece of white cloth (you can use an old bedsheet)
- A mirror
- A 'Marty antenna headband'

With the help of your friends, teachers and parents, paint the white cloth into a magnificent rainbow. When the paint is dry fix the rainbow onto the ground or on the edge of a small table and walk from one end to the other, whistling a happy tune. Pretend to slip and fall just like Marty.

Using the agility tunnel like a magical sky tunnel, climb into it and roll out of it at the other end. Imagine that you're falling through the sky, landing right onto planet earth! Take turns wearing Marty's antennas and acting out the scene!
